Gale Databases

This is a service that provides access to diverse journals articles with complete text on computer, business, economy, health and general interest. They also include a database in Spanish.

CINAHL

CINAHL® with Full Text is the world's most comprehensive source of full text for nursing & allied health journals, providing full text for more than 610 journals indexed in CINAHL®. This authoritative file contains full text for many of the most used journals in the CINAHL index – with no embargo. Full-text coverage dates back to 1981.

NNN Consult (NIC, NOC, NANDA)

NNN Consult is the online tool for nimble consultation of the standardized languages of the nursing diagnoses developed by the North American Nursing Diagnosis Association, NANDA, the Nursing Outcomes Classification (NOC), and the classification of interventions of the Nursing Interventions Classification (NIC) as well as the links between them.

Open Access databases

OVID

Provides access to databases and scores of E-Books. Offers more than 100 databases to support the breadth of research needs in a wide range of disciplines including clinical medicine, pharmacology and more.

The official dissertations repository for the Library of Congress. More than 3,000 contributing Institutions and 130,000 works are added annually.

ProQuest Ebook Central

Features over 1,500 journals, over 20,000 Online Books, and hundreds of multi-volume reference works, databases, and other resources.



General Information

The Information Access Center (IAC) of Bayamon Campus has a Virtual Library for our on campus and long Distance students. Or mission is to facilitate the resources necessary on searching online information. This services is available at <http://cai.bayamon.inter.edu>

The students can:

- ❖ Access the catalog online iLink, databases, electronic reserve, electronic books, complete text periodicals and others.
- ❖ Have access to the majority of the electronic resource from outside the campus.
- ❖ Use the modules or instructional guides of Information Development or training.
- ❖ Ask a Librarian online.
- ❖ Petition the loan of resources or interlibrary loans.

EDS (Discovery Service Bayamón Campus)

EDS is the instrument that you are going to use to locate all the educational resources available in the IAC. With this service, you can access all resources from the IAC's databases, Online Public Catalog (iLink), and all open available in the Internet.

Electronic Reserve

Here you will find, digital material that professors register on the electronic reserve for the use of their student as supplement for their courses. They are organized by Academic Department, codification, course section and by professor's name.

Faculty Services

Information Skills

Databases

The majority of our databases can easily be access from any computer in or outside of our Campus. Instruction on how to access the databases:

- **In Campus** – access the IAC Webpage <http://cai.bayamon.inter.edu>. Click database and select the academic area of interest in the menu and then click the list of the database that is going to be used (you do not need a password).
- **Outside of Campus** – access the IAC webpage and select the option Remote Access or go through <http://cai.bayamon.inter.edu> and click List of Databases. When you select the title of the database that you desire, it will ask you to write your student Identification number (ex. Y00000000) in order to access the database.

Digitalia

It is a Hispanic database of e-books and electronic periodicals that you could have access. There are thousands of books from prestigious Spanish and Latin America editorials, as well as professional journals on different subjects.

eBook Collection EBSCO

A database that contains all of the full text eBooks that your institution purchases from EBSCO, including eBooks from your eBook Subscription Collections, as well as single eBook titles. When you acquire an EBSCO eBook it is automatically transferred into this database.

EBSCOHost Research Databases

It also has multidiscipline database, the majority in full text. This database includes professional journals and a database in Spanish.

El Nuevo Día (Electronic version)

It is the online version of the hard copy which is published daily in Puerto Rico. It provides access to the historical archive of the newspaper. This database could only be used in IAC with a librarians help.

Emerald

This database acts as a literature portal for economics, business and administration, with full text, summaries, and a support center from the principle publication in the area.
