# Information Access Center

The Information Access Center (IAC) mission is to provide educational support and be part of the teaching-learning process. We are committed in its mission and vision of our Campus. Our main objective is to provide our university community the resources and services to satisfy our user's educational needs. Our purpose is to arouse investigation and the use of modern technology in order to prepare our users professionally, culturally and recreationally.

To locate our educational resources in the IAC, we count with the EBSCO Discovery Service (EDS). This service provides the user to search all available educational resources in one place.



**The books and magazines of the IAC are protected by an electronic security system.**

## Services Areas

### First Level

#### Circulation

In the Circulation Area you can find the majority of books that are available in the IAC. These educational resources can be loaned to the users for thirty (30) days with the option of renewal. If the user does not return the item loaned in the date required there will be a charge of .10 cents per item, per day of tardiness. Near the Circulation Counter there are three (3) computers for using EDS Discovery to search for educational resources in the IAC.

At the counter, you can also start the process for interlibrary loans.

#### Individual Study Room

In this room, students can study individually in illuminated cubicles and in silence without interruptions. It is located in the Circulation area.

#### Periodicals

The Periodicals Collection (located in the Circulation Area) has periodicals publication such as: newspapers, journals and indexes.

**These educational materials can't circulate outside the IAC.**

#### Study Rooms Tertulia

The study rooms provides an environment and commodities necessary to promote professional discussions and exchanges of knowledge and ideas between students. You can also find private rooms for group study that are loaned for an hour (1) and can be used by groups of three (3) to five (5) persons. We also have three offices for faculty. These private rooms can be reserved at the Circulation counter.

#### Computers Laboratory (B-141)

The purpose is to facilitate the search of electronic information. You can access databases with complete text, Microsoft Office programs, online services, printer, Internet upon other services.



#### Reference-Reserve

The Reference Area has educational resources of rapid consultation like encyclopedias, dictionaries, atlases, almanacs and yearbooks.

The Reserve Area has educational resources and other materials reserved by professors to complement their courses for their students.

#### Photocopy Services

The photocopy machines area located in the first level of the IAC and has a cost of \$.10 per page.

**The machines and other electronics equipment's are turned off 15 minutes before closing.**

#### Permanent Expositions

##### Los Caprichos de Francisco de Goya

The IAC has one of the complete notable engraving series of the Spanish Painter, Francisco de Goya: *The Caprichos*. It is composed of eighty (80) stamps made of great domination of the technique of aquatint etching.
